<u>A.O.B</u>

Strictly Southampton

Suggested that written pitches all have the same format.

AB brought a lot of munch...felt that was worth mentioning.

CH brought lunch and AB sucked at guessing it – GT said it was horrible

Self-written show discussion

Committee welcome JM who is writing his own musical and felt showstoppers was a good group to go through for this.

JM - Musical not quite written. Music done, first act finished

LE – We've done one self-written independent show (Freelancers).

AB – Independent (is the slot), explained what self-written is and the varying slots we have for shows.

LE – Independents was for self-written in mind, we had one go to Edinburgh and Freelancers last year. Would have to pitch it to us and find a team, put together a pitch with an idea when to do it in the year. Society can help as Independent is new to us and we are adapting the slot. GT and BN (*#TeamGB*) could help with workshopping it.

GT – Recommend this before pitching, give feedback and how it can be improved.

- LE Platform to get people interested, workshop is a good start.
- JM How would it work?

GT – We run most workshops but do let others come in. You would say a date (which would be on a Wednesday) and with support from Team GB teach a couple of songs or read script. GT or BN would help you in regards to teaching the songs (committee unanimously felt GT would be more suited – BN moaned). GT and BN would be there the whole workshop to support, can hear what JM's musical sounds like out loud. Would get feedback – verbal or written. E.g. workshop before Christmas – feedback – then another workshop after.

At this point I wonder whether or not GT has taken a breath yet.

GT – Freelancers gave us a draft pitch, would be nice to hear music before or during to get an example. (*GT takes a breath*).

- JM How long are they?
- GT It varies, e.g. can be 2hrs or if only 1 hour can fill the other hour.
- BN We keep going till everyone is bored. (Do you really BN...like really really?)
- GT 4 hours is about max.
- CH Probably useful to talk to other Freelancers writer to help?

LE wanted food, most gone already. GT ate most of the strawberry laces, like usual.

JM – Workshop would be a good idea, band parts need writing, wondering how quickly could create something, and this year may be too soon. May could be a good slot, time before September to finish it and work constantly on it.

GT – Sunday 14th-20th of May free, would be the same week before exams. Slot where there are no shows so not to clash with other shows.

EF – Freelancers had 7/8 weeks and had a good cast – so no problem there.

BN - More time than freelancers had if workshop before Christmas.

GT – Could have problem sourcing band, as back to back shows and no weeks off. Would have to be a low tech slot in a similar way to freelancers.

JM – Ye that's fine as not an orchestral show.

GT – pros and cons – later pitch more developed show, earlier pitch more help from showstoppers to sort stuff out.

EF – Aren't we being trained? (In regards to lighting and sound)

Others – Ye so worst comes to worse we could help.

LE – Essentially no pressure, do when you like, pitching/workshop wise.

AM–Just keep us updated.

GT – If next year need to do when annex slots are sorted out – early June, not a problem just need to wait for slots to be sorted. Even if not in annex need to consider it doesn't take audiences away from other shows.

EM - What's it like, can you explain more about it?

JM – Called help, about 6th form life and people needing/giving help. Lead (Michael) goes to new school, meets person (Alex) who doesn't know he's gay (audience don't know etc) – underlying tension with this. At end of act Alex tries it on with Michael (who isn't gay) - not friends anymore. 2nd act shifts to focus on Alex, who goes out with a girl to overcompensate. This musical deals with serious issues but must be dealt in a way that it should not offend anyone. Rapes girlfriend who thinks it's her fault and confides in Michael. Michael confronts Alex, he then wants to kill himself. Bleak ending cutting himself and Sophie tries to help him. Kills himself but with Michael trying to stop bleeding and then while dying he slits Michael throat. *DUN DUN DUUUUUN!*
